

# Science Chai in the ECC



New this year! With the belief that science and Jewish connections are everywhere, the Minnesota JCC ECCs introduced a new curriculum – Science Chai, a holistic approach to learning that includes sensorial, hands-on, and sequential STEAM (Science Technology Engineering Art and Math) learning.

Examples include learning about the science of fire while lighting the Hanukkah candles, exploring the calendar through astronomy and the moon cycles around the Lunar calendar, pop-up archaeological digs during sandbox time, understanding environmental science through composting, recycling, trash-pick up and gardening, and so much more.

"We are so excited to have added this module to our two ECC's learning," said Lisa Rosenfield, Director of Childhood Services. "This is one more way for children to look at our world and how they fit into it."

### **35 YEARS AND STILL GOING STRONG!**

This year, the Minnesota JCC is celebrating Tami McDonough's over 35 years at the Minnesota JCC Sabes Center's Early Childhood Center. This long in any job is exceptional, but the impact of being an ECC teacher for over three decades is extraordinary.


"If I had to describe what makes a great ECC teacher in one word, it would be TAMI," said Erin Waller, Sabes Center's JCC's Early Childhood Center Director. "Every day, our teachers show up with a commitment to foster a joy of learning. Tami has watched our children grow – from our smallest babies to having families of their own. She is a champion."

While today might seem like a normal Tuesday, for the preschoolers in Tami's class, today is special. Tami has transformed a portion of her classroom into a post office, where children can write and mail letters, use stickers for stamps, and learn about how the mail works. Or, she has transformed her space into a Target or a Starbucks. "The children love to walk in and find something new," she said with a smile. "I love bringing things from their outside world into the classroom and to see how their minds process these experiences."





"Being an early childhood teacher is the most rewarding job I could ever think of. I get to watch children discover new skills and find out more about themselves as they do. I help them prepare and meet new challenges. Every day is different" said Tami. She added, "I have worked with hundreds of kids in classrooms, art classes and other enrichment classes over the years and I truly feel my work is valued. I couldn't be more proud of my time in the ECC."



After two long years, the JCC welcomed nearly 20 children to the stage this spring, participating in our All Children's Theater production of Seussical the Musical. Transporting us from the Jungle of Nool to the Circus McGurkus, the Cat in the Hat narrated the story of Horton the Elephant to sold-out performances, bringing lots of laughter and a wonderful time for the players and the audiences! We are so excited to bring back this program and look forward to our fall production.

Too busy. Don't know anyone. Not sure what it is... These are just a few of the reasons why so many local Jewish teens are either minimally engaged in Jewish life or not engaged at all.

But the value of Jewish teen programming continues to be crucial – impacting the next generation's future connections to Jewish life, their choices to further explore what Judaism means to them, and their attitudes and involvements in the Jewish community.

The JCC has a rich history and strong partnership with BBYO, the B'nai Brith Youth Organization. With a priority to grow Jewish teen engagement, we knew that we had to reimagine our program and began working to build a functional and supportive network among the Twin Cities' youth and teen professionals. Additionally, Steve Mintz, the JCC Director of Programming, began meeting

with Twin Cities clergy and lay leaders to build collaboration and connection.

"Getting teens involved often means meeting them where they are," said Alyssa Cohen, JCC Teen Director. "Sometimes it starts with casual meeting. Or a conversation that I or an active teen initiates. Or a personal invitation to come to an event

knowing that someone will be there to meet them. It's about creating a comfortable entry point that is welcoming."

And, this approach is working! JCC Teen programming has grown to over 150 local teens who are enthusiastically participating in a wide range of Jewish experiences – Jewish sports leagues, regional and national Jewish conventions, collaborative group activities, leadership and Tikkun Olam opportunities, and social programs.

Wendy & Howard Bach, the JCC is able to build upon our momentum in growing Jewish teen engagement that will not only impact the lives of the teens but will positively ripple through our entire community. 












Our inclusion philosophy is woven into the fabric of the JCC, working to build community where everyone acknowledges and respects people's differences, while celebrating our inherent uniqueness and individual gifts. For people with disabilities, we strive to include everyone of all ages and abilities in our programs.

While the past couple of years has created challenges for everyone, for adults with disabilities, the isolation and confusion brought on by COVID has been an exceptionally difficult and confusing time. Throughout the pandemic, we have continued to find meaningful ways to keep us all connected and are so excited to come back for inperson programs.

The Inclusion Program is made possible through the generosity of the Toodie and Frank Trestman Special Needs Collaborative Education Endowment Fund, a designated fund of the Jewish Community Foundation of the Minneapolis Jewish Federation, the Numero-Steinfeldt Foundation Endowment for the Jewish Community Center Inclusion Program, Lynne and Andy Redleaf Foundation, and with support of private, designated funds and foundation donors.

### **OUR GARDEN IS A YEAR ROUND INCLUSIVE EXPERIENCE**

In Minnesota, the word 'garden' likely conjures up images of warm temperatures, sunscreen, and the lazy days of summer. But, our JCC Community Garden brings people of all ages and backgrounds together for a year round experience that goes well beyond planting and watering – it embraces art, food, science, social studies, ecology, all rooted in the Jewish values of Acts of Loving Kindness (G'milut Chasadim), To Work and Keep the Land (L'ovda U'l'shomra), and Repairing the World (Tikkun Olam).

JCC Inclusion participants' passion for the garden is what ties the project together, while inviting and welcoming the collaboration and partnership of others to make the garden come alive. Anita Lewis, JCC Inclusion Director proudly stated, "From the very first step of sprouting the seeds to the late fall harvest to the bounty that is reaped year-round, our garden creates a magical experience that intersects beauty, education and community."


The current Hebrew year, 5782, is a shmita year. Shmita means "release" in Hebrew and refers to the seventh year in a seven-year cycle (like the seven-day cycle culminating in Shabbat). According to the Torah, during the seventh year, God commands us to let the land rest, release debts, resolve disputes, and to open our hands and hearts to those in need. *The Shmita Project*, a project of Hazon, asks us to consider: how do we bring this tradition alive in an era when we no longer rely on the rhythms and harvest of our fields to survive?

Featuring submissions to Hazon's Shmita Project, this multimedia exhibit showcases artwork from all over the country with related programming that will engage the community with the art, and provide opportunities to gain their own personal insights about shmita.


