# Pasover Sundown April 5 To





This eight-day festival celebrates the biblical account of the Israelites' redemption and escape from 400 years of Egyptian slavery. The observance of the weeklong festival includes several important rituals, including the removal of leavened products from our homes and a traditional Passover meal known as a seder, where we retell the exodus story. We come together with friends and family to celebrate the great lessons of the story: the blessing of freedom and the reminder that since we were once slaves and were freed, it is our responsibility to work for freedom for all people, everywhere.

# What To Do

Right before Passover, remove all traces of leavened bread from the home and replace with matzah and Passover foods.

Attend a Seder on the first two nights of Passover. This ritual meal involves a retelling of the story of the Israelites' liberation from slavery in ancient Egypt.

# What To Eat

Matzah (unleavened bread), fruits, vegetables, eggs, dairy, meats, fish, and packaged products with a Kosher for Passover stamp.



# What Not To Eat

Chametz, food products made from wheat, barley, rye, oats, spelt, or the derivatives, which has leavened (riser Flour from any of these five grains that comes in contact with water will leaven unless fully baked within 18 minutes. Ashkenazi Jews don't eat corn, beans and rice, but Sephardic Jews do.

# The Passover Seder



Four cups of wine are drunk to represent the four expressions of deliverance promised to the Jews.

A fifth cup is set for Elijah the prophet.

The Haggadah, a prayer book, outlines the 15 steps in the seder sequence and tells the story of Passover.

Matzah, unleavened bread eaten during Passover, symbolizes what the Israelites took when they fled Egypt.

#### ON THE SEDER PLATE:

KARPAS, parsley, represents spring.

EGG, represents fertility & spring.

MAROR, horseradish, symbolizes the bitterness of slavery.

Z'ROA, a roasted shank bone, symbolizes the paschal sacrifice.

CHAROSET, a mixture made with chopped apples, nuts, wine, and cinnamon, represents the mortar the Hebrew slaves placed between the bricks.






**CAMP OLAMI** transforms the 23-acre, tree-lined campus of the Sabes Center Minneapolis, into a magical destination in the heart of the city!


### **GAME ON!**

In the Fall of 1982, with only six students enrolled, the JCC became the home for Northern Lights School for Strings, one of the most highly-sought-after music education programs in the Twin Cities. Based at the Capp Center St. Paul, the program has grown steadily with over 100 students and a faculty of six.

"For 40 years, the Northern Lights School for Strings has filled the halls of the JCC with music, bringing joy to children, families, and our community," said Michael Waldman, Minnesota JCC CEO. The partnership between the JCC and Northern Lights School for Strings has done more than produce beautiful music. It has fostered self-esteem, confidence, and music appreciation for our students, and has encouraged a sense of belonging and an inclusive community where they feel welcomed and celebrated."

Founded by Ellen Kim, the program offers private and group lessons in both violin and cello, with students ranging in age from four to 18. Michael added, "We are so grateful to Ellen Kim for her passion and commitment to creating such an exceptional experience for young musicians over the years. We are in awe of her leadership and the amazing teachers who have worked with students for over 40 years."

This past fall, the Minnesota JCC and Northern Lights School for Strings celebrated the 40-year milestone with an Anniversary Concert that included the current roster of students performing alongside many alumni from as far away as New York City and Gothenberg, Sweden.







#### EARLY CHILDHOOD

With two Early Childhood Centers, we operate the largest Jewish preschool experience in Minnesota, where we foster confidence, joy, and a love of learning.

#### JCC SUMMER CAMPS

Minnesota JCC summer camps provided a range of experiences built around the great outdoors, comradery, lifelong skills, and lasting friendships.

#### **YOUTH AND TEEN**

As the fastest growing BBYO community in the country, we offered innovative and welcoming opportunities for learning and growth open to all Jewish teens, fostering our future Jewish leaders and community. The JCC also offered opportunities for school aged children to stay connected through after-school and school release programs, youth theater, sports & recreation, leagues, swim team, music lessons, and more!

#### INCLUSION

Children with a range of disabilities were fully integrated into our summer camps right alongside their peers. Adult programming included a wide range of enrichment, social, and growth opportunities to help achieve personal goals within the community.
