MARvelous Education Fund: Higher Education Scholarship Application

General Eligibility

All Minnesota JCC members and staff are eligible.

Scholarships are available to degree seeking students in a post-secondary program at an accredited college or university.

Criteria

The MARvelous Education Fund Committee awards scholarships based on:

- JCC involvement
- Scholastic performance
- Financial need
- 1. Preference is given to individuals with a history of involvement at the JCC, who also have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement and have financial need.
- 2. The MARvelous Education Committee has a very broad definition of financial need as the cost of post-secondary education is very high. The committee considers a number of areas to determine financial need.
- 3. Applicants can re-apply for the MARvelous Education Scholarship every year, regardless of whether they have or have not received this scholarship in past years.

Timetable

Completed applications, with all required attachments, are due no later than February 28, 2025. Applicants will be notified of a decision before March 31, 2025.

Awards

The fund will award a \$5,000 scholarship.

The JCC will issue payment directly to the college or university upon receiving a tuition invoice from the award recipient. Funds may be applied to tuition and academic fees only. Tuition bills must be received before December 31st of the year they are granted, otherwise the scholarship is forfeited. Applicants are encouraged to apply to other funding sources as well.

In order for your application to be processed, you must furnish the following items:

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. High school transcript and complete college transcript (if you are currently attending college), including the most recently completed semester's transcript.
- 3. Two letters of reference written exclusively for this scholarship application from an employer, a teacher, advisor, or clergy; not from friends or family members. Letters should be addressed to the MARvelous Education Fund Committee. Letters should address academic achievement, character, and their vision of where your education will take you. Each letter should be submitted in a PDF document, no longer than two pages. Reference letters can be emailed directly to sarag@minnesotajcc.org or submitted with the rest of your application items.
- 4. One letter of recommendation from a member of the JCC Staff or Board of Directors (current or former).
- 5. An essay no longer than two pages, and submitted as a Microsoft Word document, that answers the following questions:
 - How has your involvement at the JCC shaped the person you are today and how do you see yourself connected to the Jewish community in the future?
 - What are your academic and/or career goals?
 - In 100 words or less, why would you like to receive the MARvelous scholarship?

Your application will not be reviewed unless all items are received no later than February 28, 2025.
